



BENCHMARK indices Sensex and Nifty took a beating on Thursday and dropped over 1 per cent each, weighed by selling in major Reliance Industries, IT and banking stocks amid weak global trends.

The BSE Sensex fell 770.48 points or 1.29 per cent to end at 58,522.57, while the NSE Nifty declined 216.50 points or 1.22 per cent to close at 17,542.57. On the other hand, Nippon, Tokyo, Hong Kong and Shanghai mid-tier stocks made a recovery, trading in the negative zone during mid-session deals.

The US markets had ended in the red on Wednesday. Meanwhile, the international oil benchmark Brent crude declined 2 per cent to USD 93.79 per barrel. Gold bought shares worth Rs 4,165.96 crore on Tuesday as per exchange data. Markets were closed on Wednesday on account of Ganesh Chaturti.

Coal stock at electricity generating plants rises to about 30 MT: CIL

NEW DELHI Sept 1 (PTI)

COAL stocks at power generating plants rose to about 30 million tonnes last month, state-run Coal India said on Thursday, dispelling fears of shortage of dry fuel during the monsoon season.

The Government has been making all efforts to build up coal stocks to avoid the recurrence of power outages seen during the summer this year. Coal India said its stock is set to 20 MT, including imported coal, ending August 22 (till 29th). This is substantially higher than 12.2 MTs of August '21 when the stock plummeted by 11.2 MTs to a record. Coal India Ltd (CIL) said that the 12.2 MTs of August '21 when the supply of fuel from CIL helped the stock stabilise at power houses. "Closing stock for the month of August '22 is at six-year high barring 2020 when pandemic fuelled slowdown saw the stock at 37.7 MT," it said.

With a total stock of about 31 MTs in its godowns, around 20 MT stock at power plants and a little over 10 MT at PSUs' sidings, goods sheds, private washeries, port, captive plants there is sufficient availability of coal in the system, the maharashtra firm said.

Besides supply of coal to the power sector also rose 24.3 per cent to 10.2 MTs. The total coal supply of the current financial year, CIL production by CIL during April-August period also increased by 21 per cent to 25.3 MT, over 20.8 MT in the year-ago period.

"This level of increase was achieved despite increased demand from the power sector, cement, fertiliser, steel, LPG and MCI (Maharashtra Coal India) Ltd," it said.

CIL production last month rose to 4.25 MT, against 4.25 MT in the corresponding month of the previous financial year.

Gold declines Rs 195; silver drops Rs 863

GOLD price in the national capital declined by Rs 195 to Rs 50,722 per 10 grams on Thursday and fell in international precious metal prices, according to HDFC Securities.



snowfall in winter, it was a routine practice for the Indian and Pakistani sides to vacate some of the forward posts in these areas during winters and reoccupy in summers. But, Pakistan breached this mutual trust and deceitfully occupied fortified several locations that were either vacated in winter (as per the tradition unoccupied on the Indian side of the LoC).

The main areas where Pakistani intrusion took place included heights of Mashkoh (also spelled as Mushkoh) valley, along Marpola ridge line in Dras (also as Dras), in Kakkar near Kargil, in Batalik sub-sector to the east of river Indus, the heights above Chorbatla and Turtok sub-sectors. Several peaks in the area above 15,000 feet in altitude. During winters, the area is covered with snow and temperature falls to 35-40 degrees below zero degrees.

Pakistan might have been master of deceit, but it failed to realise even after several defeats that Indian forces' biggest equipment was determination and bravery. The Indian Army dealt with Pakistan's 'Operation Bad' with a massive 'Operation Vijay', on the strength of brave men, co-operation from the Indian Air Force (Operation Safed Sagar) and the Indian Navy (Operation Talwar) in different areas, surprise the locals, and scripted an unparalleled story of victory after initial surprise.

The 8 Mountain Division was inducted into the Sector on May 29, 1999. It retook control of Dras and Mushkoh sub-sectors on June 1, leaving 3 Infantry Divisions responsible for Kakkar, Batalik, and Turtok sub-sectors. Gradually, the Indian forces turned the tide. The first success of the war was achieved by the Ladakh Scouts on May 31, when they reached Chorbatla watershed on June 1. This was followed by the historic recapture of Tololing (June 13), Tiger Hill (June 6) in Dras sub-sector and Kakkar, Batalik, and Turtok sub-sectors by July 26. As the war drew to a close on July 26, this particular date is celebrated as 'Kargil Vijay Diwas' every year. In 2019, there will be Silver Jubilee of 'Kargil Vijay Diwas', commemorating India's victory in the Kargil war of 1999.

Of course, the victory was not an easy task. Apart from Pakistan, the rugged terrain, icy cold wind, snow, steep climbs, and challenges thrown by the high altitude just made difficult the Indian task of ridding the positions of Pakistani intruders. But, not to be bogged down by challenges, and rising above the odds, the Indian forces brought down the curtains heavily on Pakistani misadventure. Also, the Kargil war of 1999 was India's first televised war. During 'Operation Vijay', 559 brave Indian soldiers made the supreme sacrifice in the highest traditions of the Indian Army. Be it 1,536 soldiers were wounded, reads a plaque at the Kargil War Memorial at Dras.

Since the 1999 military misadventure, Pakistan has not dared to mess with India's determination in protecting own territory. So, as of today, the entire line of control along Srinagar-Leh is largely secured. The Indian forces are located at the front-line posts and guarding the Indian territory, withstanding the vagaries of the weather.
