THE **Cu**RIOUS CASE OF COPPER

As our presence in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) solidifies, the month of march witnessed two major milestones:

1 Commercial production at Katanga Copper Belt

Commercial production of copper cathodes commenced at our 12,000 TPA SX-EW copper processing plant in the Katanga Copper Belt, DRC.

The first copper cathodes produced from the electrowinning circuit confirm the plant's operational readiness and mark the beginning of commercial operations at the facility.

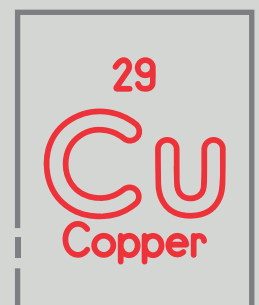
The project combines established mining licences, ready infrastructure and high-grade oxide copper resources, enabling efficient SX-EW processing and supporting a disciplined scale-up of production as mining and ore supply stabilise.



2 Acquisition of the Chemaf Group

We expanded our footprint in the DRC through the acquisition of the Chemaf Group via Virtus Lloyds Minerals Holding (VLMH). This strategic move includes the Etoile Mine & Plant, which is currently operational with a capacity of 20,000 TPA of copper and 4,000 TPA of cobalt.

Additionally, the acquisition brings in the Mutoshi Project, a world-class development expected to add 50,000 TPA of copper and 16,000 TPA of cobalt to the company's portfolio. With access to over 50 mining permits and exploration licenses, this acquisition cements Lloyds' position as a key player in the global copper and cobalt value chain.

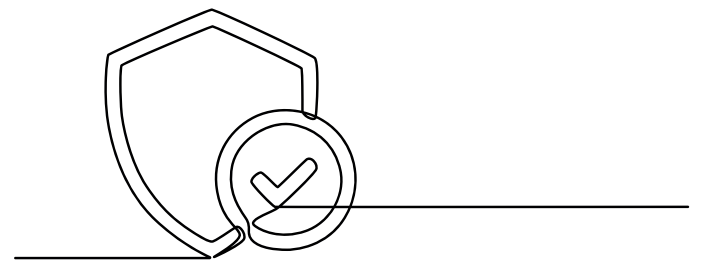

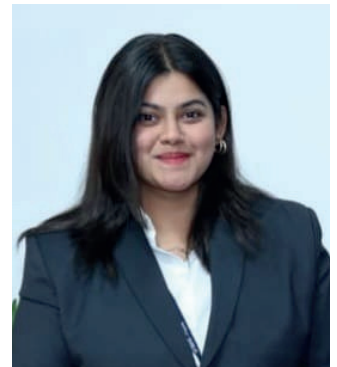
